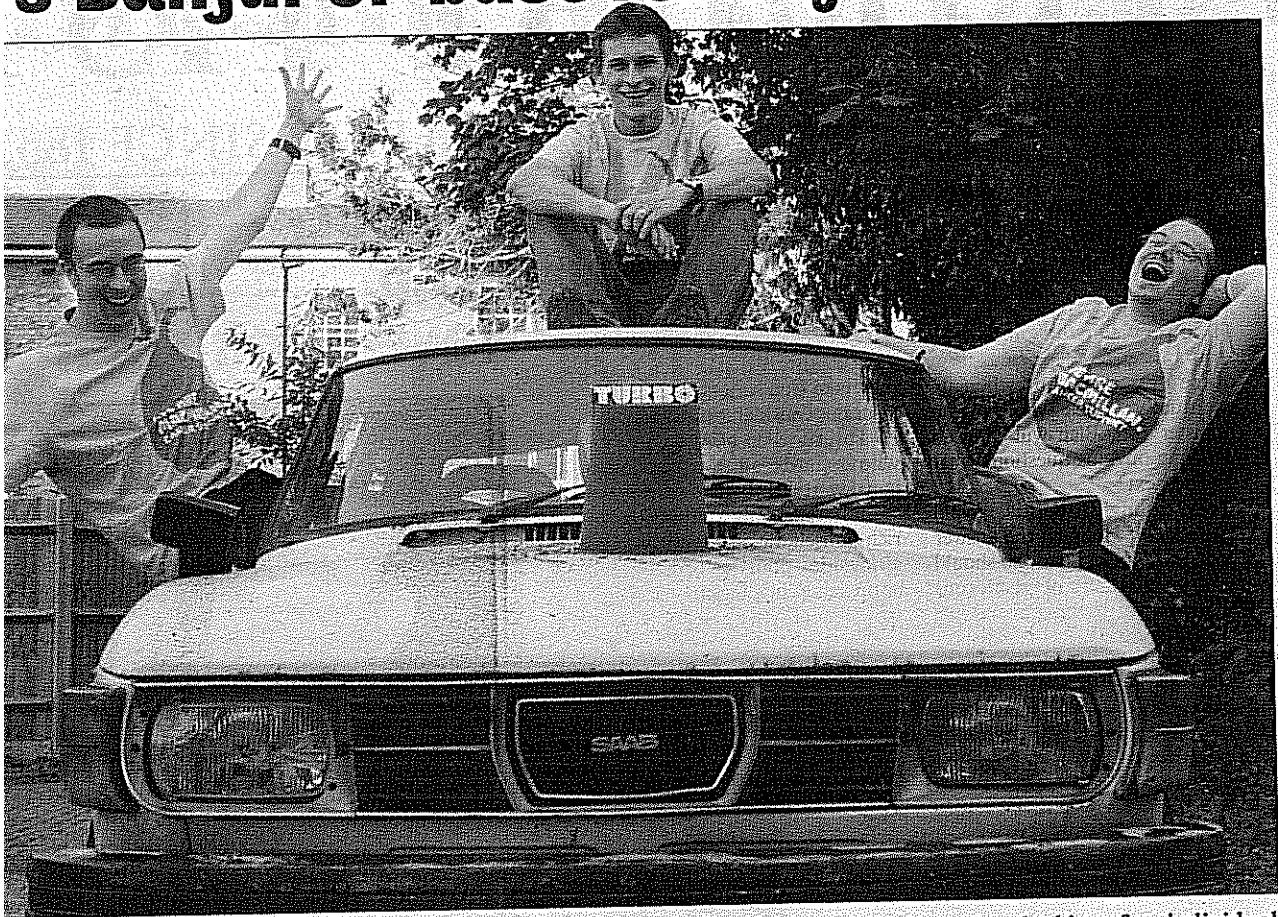


's Banjul or bust for Plymouth trio

BANJUL or bust for three young adventurous Christians preparing to take a battered old Saab all the way to West Africa.

Gareth Wallace, Jonathan Farley, and Peter Laurie will set out from Plymouth on Boxing Day in a 1978 Saab and hope to

make the 3,700 miles to Banjul in the Gambia in 22 days.

Gareth, Jonathan, and Peter hope to raise £10,000 through sponsorships, money which will go to charities Tearfund and Macmillan.

The trio, who call themselves Team Sanddodgers, have been sponsored by names such as Spar UK and Danone,

but are also looking for individual sponsors.

They are travelling as part of the 2007 Plymouth to Banjul challenge, which stipulates that each team's car must cost no more than £100.

'It involves travel, adventure and raising money for charity,' said Gareth. 'All such worthwhile things to do.'
